GRANT OVERVIEW

The **Bridging the Gap** grant allows educators to create innovative, equity-focused classroom projects that benefit underserved students. This initiative aims to address resource disparities and support the unique needs of students in our district, improving engagement, achievement, and access to enrichment. **Grants of up to \$500** will be awarded for selected projects or required resources.

However, **collaboration** among multiple teachers **may be eligible for increased funding**. Applications will be reviewed, and awards will be granted on a rolling basis.

EXAMPLES OF ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Academic interventions & specialized learning tools
- Culturally inclusive materials & classroom supplies
- Enrichment activities, field trips, guest speakers
- Translation services or parent engagement efforts
